## Re: Balens, BABTAC Business Insurance scheme

## Insurance claims for business closure as a consequence of the pandemic

Several of our customers have contacted Balens to ask if their BABTAC insurance policy would help with the financial losses resulting from the coronavirus lockdown. It was therefore felt that it would be helpful if we were to make clear the position with your Insurance policy.

We expect most enquiries about your insurance cover for the pandemic will arise simply due to the required closure of business rather than any specific events concerning the presence of coronavirus at your premises.

The BABTAC policy wording provides cover for Business Interruption under Section 2. Where the premises have been closed due to Government guidance, the policy requires it to be by a specified disease. The diseases are listed in the policy wording and this does not include COVid-19.

Businesses and turnover affected by social distancing measures, or by staff or customers feeling unwell, are also not covered by the insurance policy.

We understand that many of our customers are experiencing considerable hardship and distress at a very difficult time for all. We fully empathise and we are sorry that we cannot help but we do hope that we have explained our position clearly and you understand why we have made the decision that we have.
